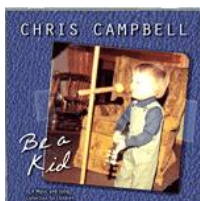
Thank you!

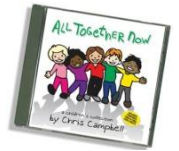


The New "Be A Kid" Collection!

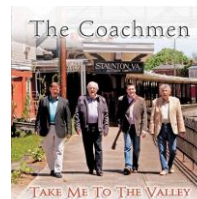
